➤ Checking System Readiness in Rosetta Stone


Each learner's system must be compliant with a minimum set of features for Rosetta Stone to work properly. You can log onto the Rosetta Stone web site and check your system to ensure you have the minimum requirements.

Here's what to do.

1. Log in to Rosetta Stone at <http://nasa.rosettastoneenterprise.com/en-US>.



2. Click on the **First Time Users** link.



3. Click on the **Check System Readiness** link.
