



Rebecca Dubuisson

Rebecca S. Dubuisson was appointed to the federal Senior Executive Service (SES) in September 2007, and has served as the Deputy Director of the NASA Shared Services Center (NSSC) in Hancock County, Mississippi since March 2012.

As deputy director of a multi-function shared services center, which includes financial management, information technology, human resources, procurement services, and business support services, Ms. Dubuisson provides agency services to NASA employees, contractors, grantees, and vendors.

Dubuisson began her NASA career in 1988 at the Stennis Space Center (SSC) as a Procurement Analyst in the Procurement and Business Management Office. She was responsible for awarding and administering the center's institutional requirements, including facility operating and security services and all construction contracts. She also successfully led the implementation of the ISO 9000 certification process for the center by establishing strict internal control assessment requirements.

From 1999 to 2003, Dubuisson served as Procurement Officer for SSC and was the Center's advocate for competitive sourcing. Under Dubuisson's leadership, the office satisfied procurement responsibilities in propulsion testing, Earth science applications, education, research and development, as well as those requirements for the over 30 other federal, state and governmental agencies located at the space center.

After leading a year-long propulsion test operations source evaluation board that resulted in a multi-center propulsion test contract, Dubuisson was named the SSC Program Manager for the implementation of NASA's Integrated Financial Management Program.

In 2005, Dubuisson joined the newly forming NSSC as Deputy Director, Business & Administration. She became Director of this group in early 2007 and served until March of 2012.

In this capacity, she managed the NSSC's operating budget of \$320 million in the Working Capital Fund (WCF), approximately \$100 million in non-WCF, and supported total payments of \$18 billion a year for labor, travel, accounts payable and grants across NASA.

Dubuisson has received numerous awards, including the NASA Exceptional Achievement Medal, NASA Special Service awards, Group Achievement Awards, and a Vice-Presidential Hammer Award.

A graduate of the Florida Institute of Technology, Orlando, Florida, with an M.B.A., Dubuisson holds a bachelor's degree in business administration from Delta State University, in Cleveland, Mississippi.
