

The Enterprise License Management Team (ELMT) manages strategy and negotiations leading to the establishment, and maintenance of enterprise agreements for commercial application procurement, licensing and contract consolidation. Enterprise agreements optimize cost savings by leveraging the full purchasing capacity of the Agency based on economies of scale and consolidates the procurement process under the umbrella of the agreement for streamlined purchase requests.

By leveraging the ELMT, NASA can improve the Agency's ability to identify, acquire, distribute, and manage software—and save NASA funds to use elsewhere. The establishment of Enterprise-level

Agreements sets a goal of achieving cost avoidance and streamlining the procurement process through a flexible agreement capable of meeting the NASA customer needs and providing increased services. The ELMT Program has been active since Fiscal Year 2008, establishing new agreements that promote these goals for the benefit of NASA and demonstrates alignment with Federal principles.



Management of NASA's software licenses through the ELMT includes processes and methodology to prevent duplicative coverage and overspending. The ELMT's focus on strategic sourcing supports NASA's cost containment efforts and strives to support end user productivity at a better value. The ELMT's effort to consolidate the Agency's software requirements and negotiate enterprise agreements has the potential to realize significant savings in total cost of software/ licensing ownership. Consequently, the ELMT continues to add agreements to the ELMT portfolio each year.
