How do I login to SATERN for the first time?

➤ Create your NASA user profile in Launchpad

The SATERN login process is now consistent with many other NASA Information Technology (IT) systems. For access to SATERN, users and administrators will be required to enter their Agency User ID and profile password.

 - If you select **No**, you are prompted to enter data to retrieve your Agency User ID
- Confirm that your personal information is correct and request a temporary password
- Retrieve your temporary password from your e-mail inbox and create a new password
- Answer ALL of the security questions to reset your password in the future

- Follow steps to activate your SATERN account
- **Note:** It will take one business day to activate your SATERN account
