Mark V. Glorioso serves as the executive director of the NASA Shared Services Center (NSSC) in Hancock County, Miss., where he leads a team of more than 550 civil service and service provider employees. Mr. Glorioso joined the NSSC March 17, 2014.

As executive director of a multi-function shared services center, which includes financial management, information technology, human resources, procurement services and business support services, Mr. Glorioso provides agency services to NASA employees, contractors, grantees and vendors.

In this capacity, he manages the NSSC's operating budget of \$59.2 million and approximately \$388.2 million in additional agency-provided funding for training and initiatives of benefit across the agency.

Prior to joining the NSSC, Glorioso was director of the Center Operations Directorate at NASA's Stennis Space Center (SSC), where he led a civil servant and contractor workforce to provide support functions for propulsion testing and various resident agencies. These services included shared site-wide services, such as information technology, design and construction, security, environmental, institutional support services and business management.

Previously, Glorioso managed NASA's Applied Science and Technology Project Office after working five years at SSC in the field of propulsion testing.

Prior to arriving at SSC, Glorioso worked at NASA's Johnson Space Center in Houston for eight years on several projects related to the International Space Station (ISS). In his final position as the lead mission evaluation room manager for the space station, he developed processes for ISS problem resolution in Houston's Mission Control Center. Glorioso also has eight years of experience as a design engineer in the field of communications and tracking.

Glorioso earned a bachelor's degree in electrical engineering and a master's degree in physics from the University of Houston.
