## **NASA Implements E-Invoicing Solution**

BAY ST. LOUIS, Miss. – NASA's implementation of Department of Defense's Wide Area Workflow (WAWF) e-Invoicing solution recently went live for nearly 50 NASA contracts identified with Defense Contract Audit Agency (DCAA) / Defense Contract Management Agency (DCMA) approved invoices.

WAWF is a secure web-based system for electronic invoicing, receipt and acceptance. WAWF allows government vendors to submit and track invoices and receipt/acceptance documents over the web and allows government personnel to process those invoices in a real-time, paperless environment.

Transitioning to WAWF has many benefits. WAWF will provide vendors with an electronic mechanism to submit invoices and eliminate the requirement to submit a paper invoice. The implementation will also allow for improved payment cycle time, and reductions in late payments and interest penalties, and the cost of processing transactions. While WAWF enhances the existing payment platform, NASA continues its commitment to a robust and comprehensive internal control program that ensures that improper payment risk is mitigated or eliminated. To that end, NASA remains cognizant that ensuring the effective, efficient, and responsible use of the resources that have been provided to the agency is not only good stewardship, but also the right approach to maximizing progress toward the realization of not only our exploration goals but also meeting the objectives of sound financial management.
