

## Federal Employees Health Benefits (FEHB) Program Open Season

The 2021 Federal Employees Health Benefits (FEHB) Program Open Season will take place Monday, Nov. 8, 2021, through Monday, Dec. 13, 2021. Most Open Season FEHB changes will become effective on Jan. 2, 2022. During Open Season, any eligible employee may:

- Enroll in an FEHB Program.
- Change from one health plan to another.
- Cancel FEHB enrollment.
- Change enrollment plans.
- Change participation in premium conversion (waive or begin).

**Note:** FEHB coverage will automatically continue from year to year for current enrollees who do not wish to make any changes as long as their health plan continues to participate. **If you have received correspondence that your plan is no longer participating, you must choose and enroll in another plan during Open Season to be covered in 2022 or be enrolled in the GEHA Indemnity Benefit Plan Elevate option (the lowest-cost nationwide plan option for 2022 as determined by the Office of Personnel Management (OPM)).**

### What are the 2022 changes?

Important changes for FEHB that take effect in 2022 include:

- OPM has taken multiple actions to safeguard the health and well-being of the federal workforce and annuitants during the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic. All FEHB carriers have waived cost-sharing and prior authorization requirements for COVID-19 diagnostic and antibody testing, telehealth, or other remote care services, and will continue to cover COVID-19 vaccinations and all subsequent booster vaccines as soon as possible after FDA authorization or approval. Many FEHB carriers are offering incentives of \$25-\$75 to members for receiving a full COVID-19 vaccine. Plan brochures will be available in November with more specific information.
- There are 275 plan choices in 2022 (In 2021, there are 276.) The number of options available to any given enrollee varies by geographic location and will include at a minimum 18 nationwide fee-for-service (FFS) plans as follows:
  - 14 nationwide FFS plan choices open to all.
  - 4 FFS plans with availability limited to certain groups (Compass Rose, Foreign Service Benefit Plan, Rural Carriers Benefit Plan, and Panama Canal Area Benefit Plan).
- Additional FEHB plan choices include:
  - 192 Health Maintenance Organization (HMO) plan choices in 2022, excluding high-deductible health plans (HDHPs) and consumer-driven health plans (CDHPs). (In 2021, there are 212 HMO plan choices.)

- 37 HDHP choices in 2022, 2 of which are nationwide. (In 2021, there are 18 HDHP plan choices.)
- 28 CDHP choices in 2022 (same number of choices in 2021).
- 1 new FEHB carrier in 2022, with a new HDHP option: HealthKeepers, Inc., Virginia.
- 23 new plan choices with existing FEHB carriers for 2022.
- There are four new plan options that will now offer Medicare Part B reimbursement for individuals who also enroll in the carriers' Medicare Advantage plan: Humana Value Plan, MHBP (formerly known as the Mail Handlers Benefit Plan) Standard Option, Compass Rose, and Rural Carrier Benefit.
- Starting in 2022, FEHB carriers will have a process to review all expiring prior authorizations and notify members 45 days before the expiration of a prior authorization for a maintenance medication.
- A number of plans are leaving the FEHB Program at the end of 2021. Coverage under an enrollee's new health plan will be effective the first day of the first pay period beginning on or after Jan. 1, 2022; **for most employees this will be Sunday, Jan. 2, 2022**. Enrollees will remain covered and receive the 2021 benefits of the old plan until coverage under the new plan becomes effective.
- Some plans in FEHB will be reducing service areas without terminating enrollment codes. Employees who do not choose a new health plan will only have emergency services where they live and will have to travel to their plan's remaining service area to receive full benefits.
- Some FEHB plans will terminate options and enrollment codes. Employees in the plans dropping an option may choose a new health plan during Open Season or remain with their current plan and be switched automatically into the plan's option listed in the attachment titled "FEHB Significant Events Changes" under Table 3.

**Important:** If your 2021 health insurance carrier is leaving the FEHB Program, you must select a new plan during Open Season, or you will be enrolled in GEHA Indemnity Benefit Plan Elevate (the lowest-cost nationwide plan option for 2022 as determined by OPM). If your 2021 carrier is reducing its service area, you should select a new plan with services local to you, or you will be required to travel to your plan provider's service area for health services in 2022. If your plan is terminating options and enrollment codes, you may choose a new plan or be switched automatically to the plan's selected code. **Please see the attachment to this notice for details.**

## What are the 2022 premiums?

You may view the 2022 health insurance rates on the [OPM Healthcare 2022 Premiums](#) webpage. In the left navigation pane, click the **Active Federal Employees** link, then under **Health (FEHB)**, select the **Premiums** link.

OPM announced the overall average increase in premiums for the 2022 FEHB Program is 2.4%, which is lower than last year's increase. The average government contribution for federal employees

and annuitants (excluding postal active employees) will increase by 1.9%. The average enrollee share for federal employees and annuitants (excluding postal active employees) will increase an average of 3.8%.

## How do I enroll or make an enrollment change?

Employees wishing to enroll or change their enrollment during Open Season must do so through Employee Express online at: <https://www.employeeexpress.gov/>. If you are making a change to your FEHB during Open Season and are scheduled to retire between Nov. 8, 2021, and Jan. 2, 2022, you must submit a Standard Form (SF) 2809, Health Benefits Election Form – FEHB directly to the NSSC for processing **no later than Dec. 13, 2021**.

**Note:** The NSSC does not accept Standard Form (SF) 2809, Health Benefits Election Form – FEHB, for Open Season changes for employees who anticipate remaining on the rolls beyond Jan. 2, 2022. These changes must be made through Employee Express. As changes are made in Employee Express, a record of the change will automatically be sent to your electronic Official Personnel Folder (eOPF). You will have the opportunity to print a receipt or receive one via e-mail.

## What is Employee Express?

Employee Express is an automated system that puts you in control of processing your own health benefits along with other discretionary personnel and payroll actions. Use of Employee Express is mandatory to make FEHB changes during the Federal Benefits Open Season, unless you are retiring prior to Jan. 2, 2022. If you have lost or forgotten your Employee Express password, you may obtain a new one by clicking on the **Forgot Login ID or Forgot Password** link on the Employee Express home page at: <https://www.employeeexpress.gov/>.

## What is premium conversion?

Premium conversion uses federal tax rules to let employees deduct their share of health insurance premiums from their taxable income, thereby reducing their taxes. All employees are automatically enrolled in premium conversion. If you waive premium conversion, the amount of taxes you pay will increase, as you will no longer benefit from pretax dollars. Employees wishing to waive premium conversion during Open Season must do so through Employee Express at: <https://www.employeeexpress.gov/>. To access the premium conversion module in Employee Express, from the Home screen, under the Payroll / Personnel heading, click the **Federal Employees Health Benefits** link. Then, click the **Federal Employees Health Benefits (FEHB) Premium Conversion** header. Instructions will auto-populate within the open box below.
