

January 2022 Pay Adjustments

President Joseph R. Biden Jr. signed an Executive Order (EO) on 2022 pay that authorizes a 2.2% across-the-board increase for the 2022 General Schedule (Base) plus an additional 0.5% in locality pay adjustments, reflecting an overall average pay increase of 2.7%. The 2022 pay schedules are effective on the first day of the first applicable pay period on or after January 1, 2022 (i.e., January 2, 2022).
