

SYRACUSE UNIVERSITY CERTIFICATE in PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION

The Certificate in Public Administration program is a 15-week program conducted at the Maxwell Graduate School of Citizenship and Public Affairs, Syracuse University, Syracuse, New York. The program is designed for experienced government managers who have been identified by their agencies as being high potential individuals.

Who Should Attend

Applicants should have 7 or more years of mid-level professional experience, including management responsibilities with some public sector work preferred.

Program Highlights

- Develop an understanding of the political, economic and social context of public administration;
- Achieve substantial competency in organization analysis and in management techniques;
- Gain experience in applying qualitative and quantitative methods to public policy issues;
- Provide participants with study options that focus on substantive coursework in advanced and specialized areas; and
- Participants are required to take selected graduate level courses and one three credit executive seminar in public administration. Other seminars are added based on student need and faculty availability.

Offerings: One semester, twice annually

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Program Dates: Spring 2012: Jan 10 -11 (orientation); Jan 17 (class begins) - May 9 (exams), 2012; May 13 graduation; Fall 2012: Aug 23 – 25 (orientation); Aug 27 (class begins) – Dec 14 (exams), 2012

Cost: \$14,640 – Spring 2012 (tuition only); Additional estimated fees: health services - 300; Student activity - \$40; Application - \$75; Executive Education Mid-career fee - \$50
