

## HOW DO I ACCESS THE NASA ACADEMY SITE ON iTunes U?

### ➤ NASA Academy on iTunes U

iTunes U offers educational multimedia content from hundreds of colleges and universities across the country. Although much of the content on iTunes is available for purchase, NASA Academy (APPEL) content is available for free and can be downloaded for transfer to most mobile devices through iTunes on your PC. If you have an iPhone or iPad you can access the content directly with the iTunes U app.

### Here's how to download NASA Academy content for offline access

1. Open iTunes from your PC and connect your device. If you do not have iTunes installed on your PC, download it from your Center's software refresh portal



2. Click the **iTunes Store** link.
3. In the search field, type **NASA APPEL** and press enter on your keyboard.



- Under **Institutions**, click the **NASA Academy of Program/Project and Engineering Leadership** link.



- Simply browse through any of the collections listed and select the content you want to access (for this example, we've chosen Project HOPE).




- Choose the content you would like to download and click the **Free** button.

The content now appears in iTunes in the **iTunes U** tab as a **Collection**.

7. Double click the **Collection** icon to view the content.



8. Double click any of the titles in the collection to begin viewing on your PC.


- If you have an iPhone or iPad, you can transfer the content on to your device through iTunes by dragging and dropping content on to the connected device listed in the menu bar on the left.

The content will be copied to your device, ready for offline viewing through your Music or iPod app, under the iTunes U category.



If you don't have an Apple device, you can still transfer the APPEL iTunes U content you downloaded in iTunes to most any smartphone or tablet. In iTunes on your PC, right click the desired content and select **Get Info**. The file location is listed under **Where**.

### Here's how to access iTunes U directly from your Apple device (iPhone or iPad)

To view iTunes U content directly on your device, you must download the iTunes U app.

1. Launch the **App Store** on your device and search for iTunes U.




2. Click on the **Free** button to begin downloading the **iTunes U** app (Note: you will also need to click the button a 2<sup>nd</sup> time to install the app)

3. Once the app is finished loading, tap the icon to launch iTunes U.



4. Enter **NASA APPEL** in the search field.

5. Tap a collection to begin the download process (for example, we've chosen Project HOPE).



6. Tap any of the **Free** buttons to download the content (note: you may be asked to enter your Apple ID and/or Password).

Your content is now available for viewing directly from your device.
